  - a. Riesling number one grape variety in production, but number 4 in utilization: at least 48% (132 tons) unutilized
  - b. Cabernet Sauvignon number one in utilization
  - c. Average farm business is still under 10 acres, median vineyard is 3.0 acres
  - d. Cover crop study continuing showing increase in organic matter in soil samples taken last year.
